A - CARICATURE CARVING- Bruce Ankeny

Pick from a variety of roughouts: Santas, Pigs, Hippies, etc.

B - HAND CARVE AND PAINT A ROOSTER CUTOUT- Ken Ramler

A version available for all levels. Blanks are 7" to 14" tall and 1/2" to 2" thick basswood. Carver decides on amount of detail. Woodburner may be used to add detail. Paint supplied by instructor.

C - PATRIOTIC EAGLE - Mary Kimball

Relief carve, wood burn and paint this stunning patriotic eagle on a basswood bark on board. Includes pattern basswood bark on board and all painting supplies.

D - OLD WORLD CHIP CARVING - Jan Jenson

Learn to do *Old World Chip Carving* with 3 easy cuts! Rubber cement the pattern on and start carving right away. First, do a practice piece to learn the technique. Students then choose a small project to carve on, such as a napkin holder, coasters, small boxes, trivets, etc. Projects range in price from \$5-\$30. You will need a good chip carving knife. There are many designs to choose from. Jan will have her books and chip carving knives for sale.

Brenda has been carving & working with pyrography for the past 13 years. She is an active member of the Central MN Woodcarvers Association and on the Board of Directors for the Rio Grande Woodcarving Show in Mission Texas. If you are a beginner or advanced pyrography student, this is the class for you. Let's learn or renew the basics and work with different techniques, emphasizing your style and

completing projects on a variety of wood species. Instructor will discuss preparation of wood, patterns, and use of burners including variety of tips and cleaning.

Students are encouraged to bring additional lighting, graphite paper and their burning units. Many patterns and designs available. Student may start with a barn project or bring one of their own. I have many patterns to choose from. Brenda is an authorized Colwood Dealer with burners, tips, wood and supplies for purchase.

L - COTTONWOOD BARK WIMSEY CONSTRUCTION AND INTRODUCTION OF BARK-TECTURE ENHANCEMENT - Norm Minske

Individual project subject matter is very flexible, and may include rustic structures, churches, small castles, light houses, bar and out houses, etc. Projects complexity will be driven by the carvers skill and fairly short amount of carving time. Experienced Bark Carvers recommended, though not necessarily required. Additionally, instructor will be introducing a variety of optional Bark-a-tecture enhancements including opening doors, framed windows, single or multileveled decks and platforms, dormers, stairs/steps and structural bracing. Bark-a-tecture enhancements techniques are introduced using minature milled lumber.
